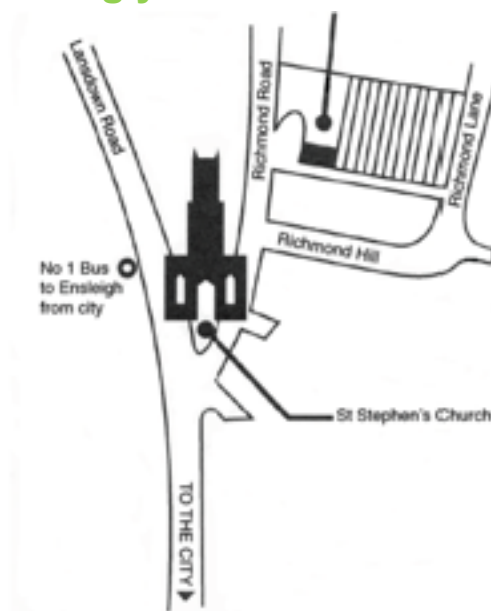

The people of Lansdown have long cherished the open ground between Richmond Road and Richmond Lane. In December 1999, St. Stephen's Millennium Green trust bought the western end of the site and the future became secure.

The purchase was made possible by contributions from the Millennium Commission, local businesses and residents. A Millennium Green has been created to serve the people of Bath. The rest of the site has been leased to St. Stephen's Allotments for 50 years.

It costs around £9,000 per year just to maintain the Green, and no funding or please consider making a donation, so that everyone can continue to enjoy this wonderful space.

Fund a Day

Make an annual contribution equivalent to one day of maintenance costs. You can even nominate a special day to have your donation linked to that day.
